SUBJECT: LABELING

TRAINING AIDS: STUDENT WORKBOOK

TIME OF LESSON: 10 Minutes

OBJECTIVES: To have students understand the information found on container

labels.

EX: ITEMS THAT SHOULD BE INCLUDED ON A CONTAINER

LABEL

SUBJECT: MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEET

TRAINING AIDS: STUDENT WORKBOOK and COMPANY MSDS

TIME OF LESSON: 55 Minutes

OBJECTIVES: To give students an understanding of what a material safety data

sheet is and what type of information is on it.

DATA, FIRE & EXPLOSION HAZARDS, ETC.

SUBJECT: SUMMARY AND APPLICATION

TRAINING AIDS: STUDENT WORKBOOK, COMPANY HAZARD COMM. PROGROM

TIME OF LESSON: 5 Minutes

OBJECTIVES: To give students a review of the informations and company Hazard

Communication Program.

EX: DISCUSS WHERE THE MSDS'S ARE LOCATED AND REVIEW

THE HAZARD COMMUNICATION PROGROM THAT THE

COMPANY HAS IN PLACE.

SUBJECT: HAZARD COMMUNICATION GLOSSARY
